









### **INSECT ART CONTEST**

Explore why real-life insects can be considered superheroes. Selected artwork will be used to create educational items. Artists that have art selected will receive a certificate and a prize to recognize their achievements. We will select a winner from each of the outlined categories and one overall winner will be selected from those entries.

- Only one artwork per student/adult per category with a completed entry form.
- Entries must be an original work by the entrant (no traced or copyright-protected images) with a label attached on the back lower right corner.
- Individual drawings and paintings must not be larger than "8.5 x 11". Original entries will not be returned, but if you want to keep the original then a jpeg or pdf of the image can be submitted. Just make sure that the image is clear.
- Entries must feature an insect as the central point of focus that fits into the theme
- Entries should be postmarked by April 14, 2023.

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### Gray County 4-H Shooting Sports Match Air Rifle, BB Gun, & Air Pistol

#### February 25, 2023 ♦ 8:00 am (registration 7:30am)

• Cost: \$10 for one discipline: \$20 for two disciplines (maximum of 2 disciplines)

### Entry forms are due by 4:30 pm on Friday February 17, 2023 Please email or fax entry forms before mailing

- This is a State Qualifier for all disciplines State match rules will be followed
  - Orion scoring system and targets will be used for all disciplines

There will be a concession stand & 1 food voucher will be provided to each participant

Shooters will be flighted by county unless otherwise requested - Coaches plan accordingly \*\*Special requests must be on the Registration Form\*\*

**Air Rifle:** Qualifying Course of Fire: Shoot 20 bull shots in each of the 3 positions. Rules will follow the current CMP National Standard 3-position Air Rifle rulebook. **To qualify for state in Air Rifle, the minimum individual score is 450 and the shooter must be at least 9 years old by 01-01-23.** 

Individual awards in Air Rifle will be given to the top 3 individual shooters in each age division. Age groups will be determined after registrations are submitted.

**BB Gun:** Qualifying Course of Fire: Shoot 10 bull shots in each of the 4 positions. Rules will follow current Daisy National Match program rules (NRA BB Gun rulebook with some modifications.) **To qualify for State in BB Gun, the minimum individual score is 335 and the shooter must be at least 9 years old by 01-01-23** 

Individual awards in BB Gun will be given to the top 3 individual shooters in each age division. Age groups will be determined after registrations are submitted.

Air Pistol: Qualifying Course of Fire: Shoot 40 shots at 10 meters (at paper targets.) Rules will follow the current NRA-USAS rulebook. To qualify for state in Air Pistol, the minimum individual score is 280 and the shooter must be at least 12 years old by 01-01-23 Individual awards in Air Pistol will be given to the top 3 individual shooters in the Junior and Senior age divisions.

Silhouettes will be shot. Individual awards will be given to the top 3 shooters the Junior and Senior age divisions.
