- 2. Must be 7-18 years of age as of January 1, current year.
- 3. Must turn in a completed Record book to be eligible for the achievement trips.
- 4. Up to a maximum of 6 trips will be awarded for each county in each age division.
- 5. Trips must be taken when offered or forfeited.
- 6. You must have a minimum of 50 points for Junior, 75 points for Intermediate or 100 points for Senior to qualify for an achievement trip
