Stevens County 4-H Council will pay the <u>\$15 state enrollment fee for any new 4-H'er</u> enrolling throughout the year in 4-H. It will also pay the fee for <u>any previously enrolled 4-H'er as long as</u> they enroll no later than November <u>30th</u>. This is one of the things that is paid with funds from the concession stand and food auction.

4-H ENROLLMENT OPENS OCTOBER 1ST

A reminder that returning 4-H'ers must be enrolled by December 1st to be eligible to show at the county fair. First-year members must be enrolled by May 1st. Which is also the add/drop date for projects. You must be enrolled in the projects you wish to exhibit at the 2023 fair. For those new 4-H members interested in livestock you must be enrolled before weigh-in dates.



STEVENS COUNTY NATIONAL 4-H WEEK ACTIVITIES

4-H Council will be hosting a 4-H Exploration Day at the Hugoton Elementary School on **Wednesday, October 5th**. 
4-H CLUB FINANCIAL REVIEWS

Gray County 4-H Shotgun Shoot Qualifying Match for Trap & Skeet

9:00 a.m. — Saturday August 27, 2022

Cimarron Gun Club - Cimarron, KS North of Cimarron on KS-23 (Main St) 1 1/2 miles north of the airport

Registration form & fees are due by: August 19, 2022

Registration form is attached

Cost: \$15.00 for trap & \$15.00 for skeet

There will not be flight times—show up ready to shoot

To participate, all youth must have completed training in their home county/district 4-H Shooting sports program for the disciplines in which they enter and be active and enrolled in 4-H Online.

When checking in, each county needs to verify their shooters information for correct age.

A shooter can qualify for state in trap, skeet or both A shooter must qualify in either trap or skeet to shoot sporting clays at state

Rules for Trap

- The shoot will be broken down into age groups after all entries are received. The top 3 competitors in each age division will receive individual awards.
- All contestants will shoot 50 clays from the 16 yard line
- To qualify for state in trap, shooters must score a minimum of **35** points out of a possible 50 points from the 16 yard line and be at least 10 years of age (4-H age)
- ♦ Ammo Specifications: New shells no larger than 12 gauge with a maximum shot size of 7 ½ lead shot and a maximum shot charge of 1 ½ oz.

Rules for Skeet

- The shoot will be broken down into age groups after all entries are received. The top 3 competitors in each age division will receive individual awards.
- The course of fire will be 50 clays
- To qualify for state in skeet, shooters must score a minimum of **30** points out of a possible 50 points and be at least 10 years of age (4-H age)

Team Awards

Team awards will be based on the grand aggregate of trap & skeet scores with the top 5 competitors in each county making up a team. Tie breaker will be the highest trap team score
