- Each 4-H member is eligible for \$75.00 per year which can be used for any event.

Tips For Writing Your Thank-You Note

- Handwritten is best and comes across most sincere, however, typed is acceptable.
- Address donor by name (in this case '4-H Council')
- Thank the donor for sponsoring your trip/ fees/ etc...
- Other ideas of what to write:
- Tell the donor what you did at event, why you enjoyed the event, what you liked most about the event, how this event helped you grow as a 4-H member, if you think you will attend event again.
- "thank you again for sponsoring my (trip to _____, fees for _____ etc...)"
- Sign with Sincerely, first, and last name.
