4-H Record Book Check List

Go to www.seward.ksu.edu, click on “4-H Youth Development”, then “forms” for all the record book pages. Each record page will have more details about requirements. Books should be put together in the following order, TABS ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED! Only include the current year’s record in the book.

- 4-H Personal Page**
 - Must have a current picture included
 - Projects you are enrolled in must be in alphabetical order (remember to put the actual project name. Ex: Instead of putting “Archery” you would list it as “Shooting Sports-Archery”
 - Must have parent’s and leader’s signature

- 4-H Story**
 - This will be an all-encompassing story, including all of your 4-H projects and activities.
 - On average, stories should be 2-3 pages

- Kansas 4-H Permanent Record**
 - Sections 1-4 complete and up-to-date
 - This can be added on to every year, so make sure to save it to your computer.

- Project Record (Choose ONE of these forms that fits your project and age)**
 - Junior, Intermediate or Senior General Project Record
 - (not eligible for state judging)
 - Junior Intermediate or Senior Animal Project Record
 - (not eligible for state judging)
 - Junior Intermediate or Senior Kansas Award Portfolio (KAP)
 - (If you would like to be judged on a state level, you MUST complete this record)
 - Must have leader’s signature on record

- Trips & Award Application (paperclip to the front of the green book)**
 - Junior, Intermediate or Senior application
 - Must have parent’s and leader’s signatures
 - This form is not a requirement of the record book. 4-H’ers can fill out this application in order to be considered for any additional awards or the achievement trip.

- Membership Achievement Pin Application (paperclip to the front of the green book)**
 - Application dependent on how many years you have been enrolled in the project
 - Must have member’s parent’s and leader’s signatures
 - This form is not a requirement of the record book. 4-H’ers can fill out this application in order to be considered for a pin award for their project.

What is changing?

Beginning with 2017-2018 enrollment, starting Oct. 2, Kansas 4-H Youth Development will be asking families to invest in the present and future of the program. With a \$15 annual program-enrollment fee, each child will have access to a wide array of development opportunities at the local, regional and state level. These structured, hands-on, relevant educational programs will continue the tradition and history of Kansas 4-H in building skills, confidence and experiences that 4-H youth will carry with them for the rest of their lives.

Why is this unified investment important?

We're working harder than ever to help young people develop into responsible contributors to their community, state and country.

The program fee is needed because the sources of funding that have historically been enough to sustain and grow Kansas 4-H are not sufficient. Declining state funding has left a gap, and looking forward at our growth ambitions – to expand and enhance our efforts to provide meaningful youth development programs – we anticipate needs for funding.

How will this investment be put to use?

Four primary investment areas were identified by the task force of Kansas 4-H professionals. These would benefit all 4-H learning environments:

- 1) Project support and enhancements (i.e. principles of engaged learning, communicate and connect learning opportunities, updating/refreshing existing project materials)
- 2) Volunteer Development (materials and coaching of volunteers; tools for recruitment, growth, evaluation and accountability)
- 3) Program enhancements benefiting community clubs (including but not limited to updating and refreshing tools for use with youth and volunteer audiences)
- 4) Foundational Supports (accessibility, campus/community partnerships and marketing at statewide events, and materials that can be used by local units)

4-H Program Fee FAQs

Why is this necessary now?

People can invest two things: time and treasure. Across Kansas there is already significant investment of time in 4-H youth development – something we're proud of and grateful for – but not every challenge can be solved by investing more time; some require investment of funds. And we have reached the limit of what we can do with declining funds.

Why \$15 when 4-H has historically been free?

No business improves and grows without investment. We understand that it's frustrating to be asked to pay for something that has always been free. We had a statewide task force that worked hard over the past year to explore all of our options and, once the program-fee concept was agreed upon, ensure the program fee was minimal for each family. With families contributing around the state, this unified investment will multiply and ripple outward in many ways.

What if a family can't afford \$15?

We have scholarships available for families who need it. No child who wants to participate in Kansas 4-H will be denied the opportunity. We plan to provide accommodations to enable ALL young people to fully participate.

Will each county collect and keep the money from its participants and/or receive a specific allocation and choose how to spend it?

No. Individual counties are prohibited by law from collecting the program fee at the county level. To manage all the transactions the same, secure way, and to ensure consistent accounting, the program fees will be collected at the state level, where allocation decisions will be made in ways that provide the best value and programmatic advantages for young people across the state.

Can you give more specific information about what you'll do with these investments?

We have a number of plans that we will be rolling out in the weeks to come. In some cases, the plans are still being formed. We have a number of options we want to provide to 4-H'ers and have not yet finished setting our priorities. We will continue to be forthcoming and transparent (see "How will this investment be put to use?").

Instructions for Seward County 4-H'ers

Here are the steps for a Seward County 4-H'er to enroll in 2017:

1. Log into 4-H Online, and begin your enrollment process, you will be asked your payment intention for the fee.
2. Seward County 4-H Council decided that each club will be responsible for the fundraising of their own fee, or pay for it out of club funds. Each club will have a credit of \$125 towards their total amount.
3. 4-H'ers will have these options when enrolling

4. If you are a Cloverbud, choose that and a fee will not be charged. All others will choose 'a local sponsor has agreed to pay my fee'.
5. Your 4-H Club will be billed for the total fee amount for your club.
6. Existing 4-H'ers MUST enroll by December 1st in order for your club to pay your fee.
7. There is also a waiver option. If you feel as though your family would financially qualify, check this box, and you will be asked to provide reasoning. You will be notified within 10 days by email if your waiver is accepted.

Kansas 4-H Youth Development welcomes you to another year of convenient online enrollment! Kansas 4-H has implemented an annual \$15 Kansas 4-H program fee. All youth will be asked to indicate their payment intention. If unsure which selection to use, please contact your local Extension office.

29. Families paying the Kansas 4-H Program Fee will have (2) options to remit payment. Cash cannot be accepted.

Please read the next steps carefully on how to proceed with a payment option. Kansas 4-H Program fees are non-refundable.

On Payment screen, click "Pay with an Existing card."


Write the 4-H youth name(s) in the check memo line or on an additional sheet of paper, enclosed with the check so payment may be applied to the appropriate member(s).

Payment is due within (7) days of submitting 4-H enrollment.
Payment cannot be made at the local Extension office.


