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**Requirements/Terms of Scholarship**

- 1. Must be a current member of a Seward County 4-H Club and a Senior in High School.
- 2. Must have completed three (3) consecutive years in 4-H, including your Senior Year of High School and completed and turned in a 4-H Record Book (containing at least one project record) each year.
- 3. In order to receive scholarship, students must submit proof of full time enrollment at the educational institution of their choice. Checks will be issued directly to the school.
- 4. If selected applicant fails to turn in a record book in September, following their Senior year, and graduation, the scholarship will be revoked.
- 5. **Scholarship is not renewable and must be used within one year of being awarded.**
