The 4-H Club year begins October 1st of the previous year and concludes September 30th of the current year. You must meet the following criteria before your application will be considered.

- 1. Must attend half of your regular scheduled 4-H Club Meetings.
- 2. Must be 10-13 years of age as of January 1, current year.
- 3. Must turn in a complete KAP to be eligible for the achievement trips.
- 4. Must participate in 4-H Council fundraiser to qualify.
- 5. Up to a maximum of 6 trips will be awarded.
- 6. Trips must be taken when offered or forfeited.
- 7. You must have a minimum of 100 points to qualify

ATTENDANCE

- Club
 - Six Meetings = 10 points

(If you attended 6 regularly scheduled meetings then you receive all 10 points)

• Each Additional after the first 6 Club Meetings = 2 points

(Maximum for this line is 12 points, which would equal 12 club meetings attended total)

- Council Member (*elected position*)
 - Council Meeting attended = 1 point for every meeting

(Maximum for this line is 6 points, which would equal 6 4-H council meetings attended total)

TOTAL ATTENDANCE POINTS

4-H OFFICER (Any office including a Junior Officer)

- Local 4-H Club = 5 points
- 4-H Council = 5 points
- Committee Chairperson = 2 points
- Committee Member = 1 point

(Maximum is 3 points must list out 3 committees served on)

4-H PROJECTS

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- Public Presentations (Outside of Club Days)
 - Illustrated Talk presented = 2 points
 - Demonstration presented = 2 points
 - Project Talk presented = 1 point
 - Public Speaking = 5 points
 - (On 4-H at event outside of 4-H)
- Completed Projects (Must have KAP in Record book)
 - 1st Project = 5 points
 - Each Additional Project = 2 points (10 Point Maximum)
 - Incomplete Projects (No records or exhibits for projects enrolled in)
 - Each Project = -5 points

TOTAL PROJECT POINTS (Maximum of 30 points)

• Entries at County Level

•	Each Individual Presentation = 5 points
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- Each Team Presentation = 3 points
- Each Group Presentation = 2 points

(Entry Composed of 3 or more persons but not club)

- Each Club Presentation = 5 points
- Placing at County Level
 - Regional Blue = 4 points (Qualify for Regional Club Day)
 - Blue = 3 points
 - Red = 2 points
 - White = 1 points
- Regional Club Day
 - Participation = 10 points

(If you qualify and attend Regional 4-H Club Day, if held, you must attend. If canceled you will be awarded the 10 points maximum.)

TOTAL 4-H CLUB DAY POINTS (Maximum of 40 points)

- County Participation (Not number of times, only if you did or did not participate)
 - Asst. Superintendent = 5 points

(Must have been approved by Extension office before fair)

- Presented a project talk of demonstration at the County Fair = 5 points
- Placing on 4-H Exhibits At County level (Placing to be considered is highest award received on exhibit)
 - Blue = 3 points
 - Red = 2 points
 - White = 1 point
