These are the rules that will govern the Kansas State 4-H Horse Show and should be used to govern local 4-H horse shows. [4-H Horse Identification Certificate](https://www.kansas4-h.org/projects/animal-science/horse/docs/SampleHorseID.pdf)- The 4-H Horse ID Certificate has been updated for the 2025 4-H program year. Please destroy previous versions of the ID form and use the update certificate moving forward. Per updated 4-H Horse Show rules, the 4-H Horse Identification Certificate must be used to properly ID 4-H horse projects by June 1 of the current program year. Breed registration papers will no longer be acceptable forms of identification. - Entries are due August 1, 2025 via [Kansas State Fair's ShowWorks entry system](#). Exhibitors must have completed ALL qualifications prior to August 1, including completing the Horse Safety Webinar and Exam. ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER AUGUST 1, 2025 WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Please note this entry system is different from static exhibits.
