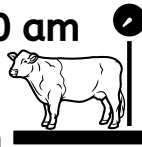

INSECT ART CONTEST

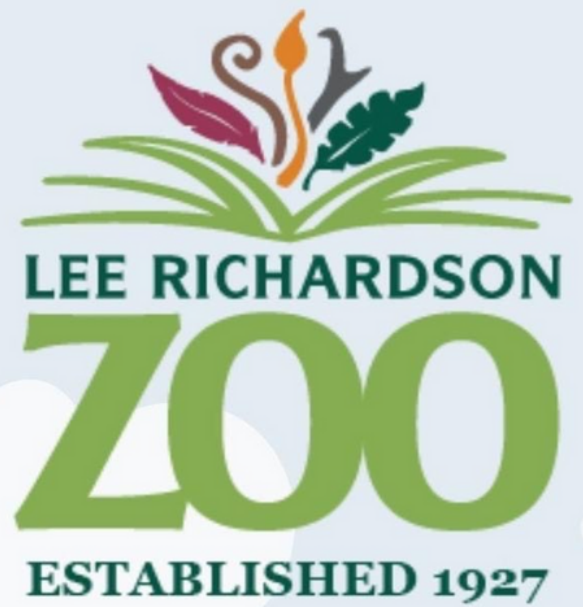
