### **DISTRICT OFFICER ELECTIONS**

As you prepare to elect your officers at your first October 4-H meeting, consider these guidelines:

- · Nominate and vote for the member who will carry out the responsibilities of the office well.
- · Remember to vote for the person you think will do the job and also regularly attend meetings.
- · Elections should not be a popularity contest.
- · Vote on each office individually. It takes time but allows important learning time for members.
- · Members can either sign up for a desired office or nominate themselves during the meeting.
- · A nomination does not need a second. It can simply be, "I nominate Jim"
- · To "close the nominations" for each office, a motion, a second, and a vote is required.
- · Voting should be done by ballot. Once again this does take time, but it is the proper way to vote.
- · Each member should have one vote per office.
- · In an office with multiple people, each member would vote for their preferred candidate.
